SPRING CLEANING

As a reminder, here are a few tips on how and where to dispose of the trash from all that spring cleaning.

WHAT IS SAFE TO DISPOSE OF IN HOUSEHOLD TRASH:

*Alkaline, Manganese and Carbon-Zinc Batteries * Plastic shopping/grocery bags * Styrofoam * To Go - Paper food containers * Water based glue * Dried latex paint * Shoe polish * Smoke detectors * Incandescent and Halogen light bulbs placed in a container so not to break through plastic bag *

WHAT IS ACCEPTED AT THE OKMULGEE RECYCLE CENTER:

*FOUR DIFFERENT GLASS CONTAINERS – **NO Lids, DO NOT MIX GLASS IN CONTAINERS**

1. Clear Glass – any clear glass
2. Brown Glass – any brown glass
3. Green Glass – wine bottles, etc.
4. Scrap Glass – window glass, ceramic, dinnerware, etc.

*TRT ROLLOFF – #1 Plastic and #2 Plastic (**NO plastic bags**) * Aluminum and Steel Cans * Paper and Paperboard Products (cereal boxes, etc.)

*GREEN TRAILER – Corrugated Cardboard, please break down the boxes

*BLACK SCRAP ROLLOFF – Metal, Wiring **ABSOLUTELY NO REFRIGERATORS, A/Cs OR ELECTRONICS**

OTHER OPTIONS FOR DISPOSAL:

*Check your local Auto Parts store for Oil/Oil Filter & Automotive/Marine Battery drop off/recycle * Okmulgee Landfill * Local Hospital, Health Department or Pharmacy for sharps & prescription drugs * Oklahoma State Extension office for Pesticide and Fertilizer * Consider donating leftover paint or other building materials * Schedule a Bulky Item Pickup with Public Works for large household items * City of Okmulgee Annual Electronics Recycle Event * Watch for Free Trash Off Days during the year * Local Authorized Oklahoma Tire Recycle Center * Consider donating old linens to an Animal Shelter* Backyard composting for food scraps, leaves and yard clippings* LED and Fluorescent bulbs to big box home improvement stores*
